Club racket bands must be on at least one of your rackets, failure to display the band may result in you being asked to leave the court until such time as you can prove membership of the club.

Children/Juniors under the age of 16 must be supervised at all times when they are at the club, except when they are participating in a formally organised activity with our team of Tennis Coaches.

The parent/carer must take responsibility for ensuring the courts are fit for play and the safety of the child whilst on the club premises outside of organised coaching sessions.
